

- KATARZYNA KOZYRA -

Warsaw, Poland

BIO

Born in Warsaw in 1963, Katarzyna Kozyra is a sculptor, photographer, author of video installations, films, performances and other artistic projects. In 1993 she graduated from the Sculpture Department at Warsaw Academy of Fine Arts (diploma "Pyramid of Animals" under prof. Grzegorz Kowalski). In 1999 Katarzyna Kozyra received Honorable mention for the Men's Bath during the 48th International Biennale of Visual Art in Venice, "because she [KK] explores and examines the authoritarian predominance of male territory and unites the elements of performance and mise-en-scene".

Her works discuss the most fundamental issues of human existence: identity, transience, death. She explores the area of cultural taboos related to man's physicality and the stereotypes and forms of behaviour embedded in social life. In each of her works, Kozyra violates these taboos, risking public outcry. Her works are exhibited at the most important galleries in the world. Since 2010 she has been working on her full-length autobiographical feature film. In 2012 she established the Katarzyna Kozyra Foundation. In March 2012 Katarzyna Kozyra started in Jerusalem her latest project "Looking for Jesus". The work is ongoing and will be developed. The premiere is scheduled in the spring, 2014 at Atlas sztuki Gallery in Łodź, Poland. She lives in Warsaw and in Berlin.
